The Pastor's Pen...

As 2023 arrives, I challenge you to make this year a time of going deeper in the Bible. There are many benefits to regular Bible reading. I'll mention a few. First, when you read the Scriptures, you get better acquainted with the Lord and His will. So much of what we don't know about our Christian faith could be known if we went deeper in the Word. Second, when we go deeper in Scripture, we give the Holy Spirit more to work with in our lives in our ongoing battle with sin and Satan. When Jesus was tempted by the devil (Matthew 4), He went on the counterattack by saying, "It is written...." The Word was His "sword," His protection. So it is with us. Third, a daily "diet" of Scripture produces spiritual strength and consistency in our Christian walk. Scripture is compared to "milk" for the immature babe in Christ and "meat" for the mature believer. The Bible brings growth! Fourth, we're commanded to go deeper in the Word. Second Timothy 2:15 says, "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (KJV). Our Lord expects us to go deeper in the Word so we'll know how to "handle" the Bible responsibly.

There are people all over the world who have little or no access to Scripture. In at least one autocratic nation, simply possessing a Bible is legal grounds for imprisonment or even death. Yet so many in this nation have risked it all for the sake of God and His Word. I once read an account where POW's in Vietnam dared to risk torture by writing Scripture on toilet paper so they could share it with other prisoners. Why are we so often "soft" when it comes to the Bible? Surely it is the work of Satan in our lives.

I will provide a hard copy of a Bible reading plan for all who want it. Just let me know. There are many phone apps that provide plans as well. Resolve to read through the O.T. in a year, the N.T. in a year, the psalms in a year, or all of the above. You determine where to start, but start if you're already not involved in regular, consistent Bible reading. What a great resolution for the new year. I love you much.
