

ANNIE ARMSTRONG EASTER OFFERING FOR NORTH AMERICAN MISSIONS

The upcoming Easter season is the time of year we as Southern Baptists focus on getting the gospel to the U.S., Canada, and several smaller territories. Our means of financing these efforts is the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering (AAEO), named for a very famous Southern Baptist missionary from another era. <u>Our primary goal this year for the AAEO is \$40,000 and our challenge goal is \$45.000.</u> We will receive the AAEO from March 19 through April 16; this means the Week of Prayer for the AAEO will be March 19-25.

Let me share with you some important facts about the AAEO:

1. Your gifts to the AAEO support more than 2,400 North American missionaries.

2. One hundred percent of your gifts to the AAEO go to the field.

3. The generosity of Southern Baptists in giving to the AAEO has allowed our denomination to plant 9,400 new churches in North America since 2010.

4. <u>Eighty-seven percent of AAEO proceeds go to support Church</u> <u>Planting.</u> This includes financial funding and benefits for church planting missionaries, training, recruitment, ministry assistance for equipment and outreach, missionary housing, and missionary care.

5. <u>Nine percent of AAEO proceeds go to support Evangelism and</u> <u>Compassion Ministry.</u> This includes evangelism resource materials and events and financial funding and benefits for missionaries involved in compassion ministry.

6. <u>Three percent of AAEO proceeds go to support Sending and Leadership.</u> This includes mobilization events, leadership resources and events, and funding for short-term student missionaries.

7. One percent of AAEO proceeds go to support Missions <u>Education</u>. This includes resources and training focused on mission field education for recruitment and mobilization of church planting missionaries.

8. Your \$100 gift to the AAEO can provide subscriptions for training resources for missionaries.

9. Your \$300 gift to the AAEO can provide Bibles and discipleship materials for missionaries.

10. Your \$500 gift to the AAEO can provide financing for a neighborhood outreach event sponsored by a missionary.

11. Your \$1000 gift to the AAEO can provide emergency travel assistance for a missionary family.

12. Your \$1500 gift to the AAEO can provide for one month's rent for a church plant.

13. Your \$10,000 gift to the AAEO can provide for worship and office equipment for a new church plant.

Remember, we need new churches to keep up with population growth. We need new churches because gospel-preaching churches are sparse in many parts of North America. We need new churches because they generally do a great job of seeing people get saved and baptized. Your sacrificial gift to the AAEO, in whatever amount God leads you to give, will make a kingdom difference for someone who needs Jesus and for our North American missionaries who are giving their all to try and reach them with the gospel.
