The Pastor's Pen...

There are two items I want to share with you this month for your prayer support and participation. First, I would like to ask you to be prayer warriors for our upcoming **Bulgaria mission trip**. I will lead a team of five members (including James Collins, Julia Barth, Jessie Smith, and Ben Lewis) as we travel to the capital city of the country (Sofia) for a week of mission work with our International Mission Board missionaries there. We will depart on Friday, May 5 and are scheduled to return on Saturday, May 13.

Here are some prayer requests for this trip: 1) pray for divine appointments as our team meets people in parks and schools for conversations as we try to discern who is willing to hear the gospel; 2) pray that we might see souls come to Christ; 3) pray that we will be an encouragement to the missionaries there as we go to work beside them; 4) pray that God will watch over our team and keep us safe and healthy while we travel and minister; 5) pray that we'll be very clear and bold as we share the gospel with the people there. Thank you for your support!

The second item is our medical supplies ministry, *A Place of Grace*. After an extended absence, our ministry leader, Melvin Wolfe, is back and in charge of this ministry. He has shared with me a particular need for wheelchairs, shower chairs and bedside potty chairs. If you have either of these items, there are always people asking for them. If you don't have them but know of others that do, please help us spread the word. Over the last years, sharing these medical supplies has provided numerous opportunities to have spiritual conversations with those experiencing this need. Pray that this ministry will continue to be an expression of Christ's love and that many gospel opportunities will continue to flow from it.
