Church family, we have got a lot of wonderful happenings and opportunities going on in June. I offer the following list both for your prayer support and your participation where possible.

Operation Joseph: The latest collection will be from June 4 – 18.
Remember this offering goes to feed the hungry, to spread the gospel, and to hopefully start new churches in Venezuela. Pray about what God will have you to give.

2) VBS: This is an opportunity to share the gospel with large numbers of boys and girls, both our kids and others. Please pray for souls! The dates are June 5 - 8.

3) Boston Mission Trip: We'll send our second mission team to Boston this year from June 8 – 12. Pray that the people at Charlestown Church will be encouraged as our volunteers go to serve there while the church ministers to the community.
