The Pastor's Pen...

When we read the headlines today, it's clear that Christian truth is under assault on many fronts. To name only two examples, there is the "transgender" revolution (as if anyone could scientifically change their gender) and the continuing assault on marriage (God's revealed will of one man and one woman together in holy matrimony until only death separates them). If you keep up with the news, you know I could name several other examples. It seems as if what was not long ago considered to be truth has now been labeled a lie and that which was considered a lie has now been labeled the truth. Things are "upside down."

So how do we keep our orientation to the truth? Obviously, the first and most important thing is to dig deeper into the Bible. We must know what God says and we must stand on what God says in these days. As it says in 2 Tim. 2:15, "Study to show yourselves approved to God, a worker that doesn't need to be ashamed; one who rightly handles the Word of truth." The Bible is our most important source of information in every age. I challenge us to be men and women of the Word.

But as a companion to the Scriptures, it helps to have trustworthy sources of information which will bring light into the darkness we often find in modern media. Let me suggest a few sources of Christian news that have helped me through the years. First, I recommend Dr. Albert Mohler's "Daily Briefing." Dr. Mohler keeps up with the news from a biblical perspective. You can sign up at AlbertMohler.com. Next, I recommend World Magazine, another fine source of news from a biblical worldview. You can subscribe at wng.org. And then there are two Baptist sources of news I recommend. First is baptistpress.com (our national Southern Baptist news service) and second is the Biblical Recorder (our North Carolina Baptist news publication that can be accessed at brnow.org).

If we know the Word and we know how to supplement our biblical knowledge with trustworthy Christian news sources, we'll be much better equipped to live by the truth and stand for the truth. So let it be in our lives. I love my church family.
