#### The Pastor's Pen...

92 It is good to give thanks to the Lord
And to sing praises to Your name, Most High;

<sup>2</sup> To declare Your goodness in the morning
And Your faithfulness by night,

<sup>3</sup> With the ten-stringed lute and with the harp,
With resounding music on the lyre.

<sup>4</sup> For You, Lord, have made me joyful by what You have
done,

I will sing for joy over the works of Your hands.

<sup>5</sup> How great are Your works, Lord! Your thoughts are very deep.

This passage encourages us to meditate on the works of the Lord and to respond to Him in thanksgiving and praise. We should never limit our response to God's goodness in our lives to a special season or holiday. Having said that, we should be so *thankful* that this season of Thanksgiving provides us with an opportunity to *focus* on the goodness of God in a wonderful way.

Meditate on the above passage this month as you consider God's works in your life. Meditate on how He has worked in your family this year. Meditate on how He has blessed you physically this year. Meditate on how He has grown you in your faith this year—perhaps through storms and trials. Meditate on how He has blessed you with the blessings of freedom in our country.

This obviously is not an exhaustive list. I simply encourage all of us to spend some time this Thanksgiving season truly focusing on our Lord who has been so generous to us. Let's give thanks particularly for the gospel of Christ. God knew us from eternity past. He set us apart. He sent His Son to die on a cross for us. He raised Him from the dead to confirm His saving power. He called us through the proclamation of the gospel. He saved us as we turned to Him in repentance and faith. He indwells us and sanctifies us by His Holy Spirit. He includes us in His saving work around the world through missions. He forgives us of all our sins. He promises us the hope of heaven where we will praise and serve Him through the eternal ages to come. What a Savior! What a gospel!

We have so much for which to be thankful for this year. I am especially thankful for all of you. What a joy and privilege to be a part of this wonderful body of believers. What a joy to be your pastor. I love you all.
