As December rolls around again, I want to highlight two items for your attention.

Oscar Benites Ordination How grateful we are that God has called Oscar Benites and his wife Catalina out of our Hispanic congregation to be a part of Englewood Baptist's staff as they plant a Hispanic Church in Roanoke Rapids. This is a fine couple and God has blessed our church greatly in allowing us to send them out as church planters. We will have the privilege of ordaining Oscar into the gospel ministry on Sunday night, December 3, at 6:00 in our Hispanic Chapel. I'm inviting all our English-speaking folks to be a part of this ordination service as well. Please come if you're able and let's pray over Oscar and Catalina as God sends them out. Translation will be provided.

**Lottie Moon Christmas Offering** I've just returned from the annual meeting of the Baptist State Convention of North Carolina. While there, I was privileged to hear again from Paul Chitwood, the President of our International Mission Board (IMB). Dr. Chitwood always, always says, "The world's biggest problem is lostness." He's right. Every single day, over 160,000 people die apart from Christ. And these departed ones enter into an eternity in hell where they will be forever separated from God.
