#### The Pastor's Pen...

As always, we like to keep you informed on important, upcoming items. Sunday mornings in February holds some special opportunities for us in pursuing Christ.

First, on February 4 we will observe the Lord's Supper. Very little that we do is more important than the Lord's Supper. It enables us to go back to the cross and to remember what Christ has done for us in offering Himself there as our substitute and redeemer. It highlights the gospel in such a powerful way. Only through His shed blood on the cross can we approach the Father. Only through faith in Him alone may we be reconciled and adopted into His forever family. Don't miss this special time of worship.

Second, on February 11, Rick Via will be our guest preacher for the day. Rick is Bob Unrue's cousin and the co-founder, along with his wife Janet, of *World Reach Partnerships*. Rick is a gifted evangelist and the father of "Smooth" Via, who has preached here in the past. God has obviously used Rick in a mighty way. The following is an excerpt from the *World Reach Partnerships* website:

He has opened doors for us to preach the Gospel in nearly 50 countries. He has enabled us to work side-by-side with missionaries and churches to advance the Kingdom of God. We have had the privilege of planting new churches, training pastors and seeing thousands of souls saved in third world countries. Hundreds of volunteers have joined World Reach Partnerships in taking the Gospel from Cuba to Cambodia, from Burma to Brazil, and from South Africa (and Uganda!) to South America.

Please plan to be here to hear the gospel of Jesus Christ proclaimed with Holy Spirit power. You will be blessed. And if you have friends who are lost or who have fallen out of fellowship with God, please invite them on February 11. After the service, take them to eat and ask them about their reaction to what they've heard. Perhaps God might save souls that day!

Finally, on February 18, we will observe the ordinance of believer's baptism. It is always such a thrill to see believers following the Lord in obedience through baptism. Baptism is a picture of the death, burial, and resurrection of Christ and also a picture of how the grace of Jesus Christ puts to death the old, sinful person and raises the new believer to a new life in Him.
