Easter Activities

As we approach Easter this year on March 31, several special activities will be taking place. Please note the following and plan to celebrate with us.

Palm Sunday Lord's Supper

As Holy Week begins, on March 24, we will observe the Lord's Supper. Please be a part of this special service.

Sunrise Service

On Easter Sunday morning, we will celebrate our annual Sunrise Service at 7:00. The service will take place here at SABC this year. Pastor Brandon Dees from Calvary Baptist will bring the message. *There will be no breakfast served this year*. Sunday School will begin at the regular time of 9:15.

Easter Choir Music

We always look forward to a special time of worship as our choir takes the first half of our Easter Sunday service to lead us in worship through Easter music.

Easter Emphasis: Jesus is Alive!

This year we will have a month-long special emphasis in March leading up to Easter. On Sunday, March 3, every family (or individual) will receive a special Easter-themed card that we can all use to invite people to our Easter Sunday service. We're asking everyone to pray that God would lead you to one unchurched person/family in your circle of relationships that you will invite to join us for worship on Easter Sunday. Start praying now about who your one will be. Again, we're not looking to invite anyone who regularly goes to another church; this is for those who don't have a regular church home. Sometime during March, we will ask all of you to prayerfully approach the one(s) God lays on your heart and give them the invitation card as you say something like: God has laid you on my heart and I just wanted to invite you to celebrate Easter with me and my family this year on March 31. At that point, you can cover all of the important details printed on the card (like date, time, etc.). And don't just invite them to attend. Go the second mile. Call them the Saturday night before Easter to remind them of the service. Offer to meet them in the parking lot. Sit with them during worship. Take them to lunch after the service and ask what they thought of the service and what they got out of it. Be creative. Let's get busy this year in sharing the miracle of the Easter story with our unchurched friends, family members, coworkers, neighbors, etc.


