ServeNC

From August 3-10, we will be participating in a state-wide emphasis called ServeNC. What is this emphasis all about? ServeNC is an opportunity for every NC Baptist church to love its community in Jesus' name through service projects. At last count, 936 other North Carolina Baptist churches are signed up with SABC to participate in ServeNC.

You'll be hearing much more soon, but here is a summary of what will be going on that week. Most every day from Saturday, Aug. 3 through Saturday, Aug. 10, we will provide service projects in our local area that you can sign up for. You don't have to sign up for every project; anyone can sign up for any project. Our goal is for at least half of our church to participate in showing the love of Jesus to Rocky Mount through these different service projects. Here are some examples of projects you'll be able to sign up for: a free car wash, children singing at a local rest home, block parties at Kings Way and Stonegate, assisting a local ministry called Peace Makers in a painting project, two meals for our local first responders, a medical mobile unit provided by the Baptist State Convention of North Carolina, and so on. We'll need volunteers for each project.

Imagine the multiplied impact of almost 1000 NC Baptist churches showing Christ's love all across our state that week! And for SABC, it will be a great opportunity to show Christ's love and maybe even to share Christ's love as we serve our city that week. The first thing I need you to do is start praying about a special sign-up Sunday for ServeNC. On Sunday, July 14, our Sunday morning service will be abbreviated so everyone can have a chance immediately after the service to sign up for projects. You'll be hearing more about this as July 14 draws closer so stay tuned. I look forward to sharing more details with you in the coming days.
