The Pastor's Pen...

Our annual emphasis on North American missions starts in March. The Week of Prayer will run from March 23 – 30. The national goal for the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering (AAEO) this year is \$78,000,000 and our Church Goal is \$40,000 and our Challenge Goal is \$45,000. As Southern Baptists, our gifts to the AAEO support more that 3000 missionaries and their families across North America.

And what a kingdom difference these missionaries are making. Since 2010, Southern Baptists have planted more than 11,000 churches across the U.S., Puerto Rico, and Canada. If we continue at the current rate, by 2030 1/3 of the SBC will be made up of churches planted by Southern Baptists since 2010. 27% of all Southern Baptist churches outside the South have been started since 2010. And 26% of all Southern Baptist church baptisms outside the South came from churches started since 2010.

No gift is too small. Every penny of every gift given to the AAEO makes its way directly to the field to support our North American missionaries. The North American Mission Board gives us an idea of how a gift of any size can make a difference. A \$35 gift can purchase a meal with an unreached person. A \$150 gift can purchase subscriptions for training resources. A \$300 gift can purchase Bibles and discipleship materials. A \$500 gift can pay for a neighborhood outreach event. A \$1000 gift can provide emergency travel assistance for a missionary family. A \$1500 gift can provide the cost of monthly rent for a church plant's facility space. And on and on it goes. Your gift counts!




