It is time for our annual year-end emphasis on international missions and the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering. This year our primary goal is \$75,000 and our challenge goal is \$85,000. Let's remind ourselves of what this emphasis is and why it's so important.

What is the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering? "At 18, Lottie Moon chose to follow Christ and her life became a testimony of hope. Years later in China, she gave herself to serving others and sharing the light of God's love in the midst of great need. In her letters home, she pleaded for prayers and support so that more people could bring that same hope to a world in darkness. Her words sparked a legacy that continues today through the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering. Every dollar you give becomes more than a gift—it brings hope, it brings light. What did your Lottie Moon Christmas Offering gifts accomplish in 2024? Here are some of the highlights of how the LMCO advanced the gospel through our 3577 Southern Baptist international missionaries: we saw 68,628 baptisms, 84,430 new leaders developed, 2409 churches planted, 144,969 professed faith in Christ, and 1.6 million heard the gospel.
