during Sunday School from in the large fellowship hall. We will cover policies, calendar, child check in, release forms & communication for the coming year.

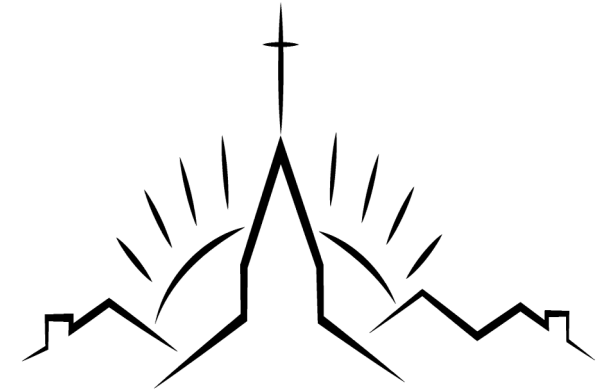
